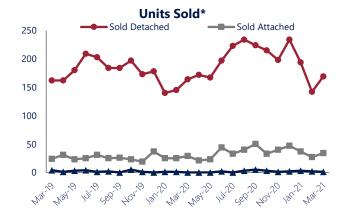

## **Active Inventory**

Versus last year, the total number of homes available this month is lower by 402 units or 63%. The total number of active inventory this March was 236 compared to 638 in March 2020. This month's total of 236 is lower than the previous month's total supply of available inventory of 297, a decrease of 21%.



### **Median Sale Price**

Last March, the median sale price for Kent County Homes was \$225,200. This March, the median sale price was \$260,745, an increase of 16% or \$35,545 compared to last year. The current median sold price is 2% higher than in February.

There was an increase in total units sold in March, with 204 sold

this month in Kent County versus 171 last month, an increase of 19%. This month's total units sold was higher than at this time last

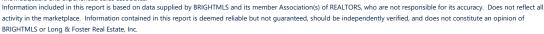

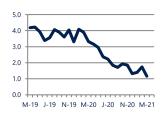

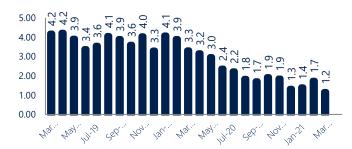

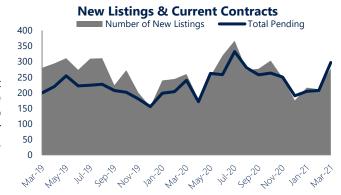
# **New Listings & Current Contracts**

This month there were 278 homes newly listed for sale in Kent County compared to 260 in March 2020, an increase of 7%. There were 297 current contracts pending sale this March compared to 240 a year ago. The number of current contracts is 24% higher than last March.

### **Months of Supply**

In March, there was 1.2 months of supply available in Kent County, compared to 3.3 in March 2020. That is a decrease of 65% versus a year ago.

Months of supply is calculated by dividing current inventory by current sales. It indicates how many months would be needed to sell all of the inventory available at the current rate of demand.

### Sale Price to List Price Ratio

In March, the average sale price in Kent County was 100.1% of the average list price, which is 1.2% higher than at this time last year.

## Days On Market

This month, the average number of days on market was 34, lower than the average last year, which was 62, a decrease of 45%.
