




Units Sold

With relatively few transactions, there was an increase in total units sold in March, with 15 sold this month in Middlesex County. This month's total units sold was lower than at this time last year, a decrease from March 2020.

Active Inventory

Versus last year, the total number of homes available this month is lower by 87 units or 70%. The total number of active inventory this March was 37 compared to 124 in March 2020. This month's total of 37 is lower than the previous month's total supply of available inventory of 53, a decrease of 30%.





Median Sale Price

Due to the relatively small number of units sold, the median sale price showed significant change this month. Last March, the median sale price for Middlesex County Homes was \$225,000. This March, the median sale price was \$468,000, an increase of \$243,000 compared to last year. The current median sold price is higher than in February.

Median sale price is the middle sale price in a given month. The same number of properties are above & below the median.

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




Sold Vs. List Price 96.8%

New Listings & Current Contracts

This month there were 14 homes newly listed for sale in Middlesex County compared to 23 in March 2020, a decrease of 39%. There were 25 current contracts pending sale this March compared to 8 a year ago. The number of current contracts is 213% higher than last March.

Months of Supply

In March, there was 2.5 months of supply available in Middlesex County, compared to 7.3 in March 2020. That is a decrease of 66% versus a year ago.

Months of supply is calculated by dividing current inventory by current sales. It indicates how many months would be needed to sell all of the inventory available at the current rate of demand.

Sale Price to List Price Ratio

In March, the average sale price in Middlesex County was 96.8% of the average list price, which is 2.0% higher than at this time last year.

Days On Market

This month, the average number of days on market was 107, higher than the average last year, which was 100, an increase of 7%.



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
